SEPSIS:KNOW THE SIGNS ACT IN TIME





TEMPERATURE

- Higher or lower than normal
- Chills or profuse sweating



INFECTION

- Signs of a current or recent infection
- May include wounds, pneumonia, UTIs, or catheter-related infections



MENTAL DECLINE

- New confusion or disorientation
- Sleepy, difficult to wake, or not acting like themselves



EXTREMELY ILL

- Severe pain or discomfort
- Trouble breathing, rapid heart rate, or cold extremities

What to Do:

- Call 911 or get emergency care immediately if sepsis is suspected.
- Early treatment can prevent organ damage and save lives.
